# TRANSPORTATION

PTDC will provide local transport to international delegates from and to the airport upon arrival and departure between 26 and 30 May 2024. #### 7. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The Meetings will be conducted in English. Simultaneous translation in any other language will not be available.

#### 8. DRESS CODE

Formal attire is recommended for all delegates.

#### 9. VISA AND PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

All participants entering Pakistan must possess a valid Passport or internationally recognized Travel Document. The document shall be valid, for more than six (6) months from the date of entry into Pakistan.

Delegates must apply and obtain a Visa in advance at any Pakistani Embassy/ Consulate abroad before entering the country. Alternatively, E-visa may be applied by visiting the government of Pakistan e-visa application portal at https://visa.nadra.gov.pk/e-visa/.

#### 10. CUSTOMS REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

The Pakistani Customs Authority has been informed to facilitate customs and entry procedures for all delegates. For further information on Pakistan's customs regulation, dutiable and prohibited items, please contact the nearest Pakistani Embassy or consulate in your country.

The Customs authorities perform custom inspections after baggage claims on passengers arriving on international flights. During inspection, the passengers may be required to submit the completed customs declaration forms which will be provided by the airline staff before landing.

# 19. ISLAMABAD QUICK FACTS

Area: 906.50 square kilometers

#### Capital of Pakistan

**Population:** 1.2 million

**Language:** Urdu is the national language, but English, Punjabi, Pashto, Balochi, Sindhi and Pahari are also widely spoken in the city.

Altitude: Ranging from 457 to 610 meters.

**Climate:** Islamabad features an atypical version of a humid subtropical climate, with hot, humid summers accompanied by a monsoon season followed by cool winters.

Islamabad is Pakistan's most diverse metropolis in terms of the population. It has the largest expatriate population in the country. Islamabad has an inviting and reasonably temperate climate, with lush green scenery and excellent infrastructure.

The city is also a stopping point for tourists travelling to the Northern Areas of the country for trekking, hiking, adventure sports and mountaineering. Since the city has been growing into a major business and commerce centre, it has attracted a large highly skilled workforce from other major cities including Karachi, Lahore, and Quetta. All the country's diplomatic ties are maintained and exercised through Islamabad.

The city is famous for its lush-green and clean environment; and is often referred to as 'The Green City'. It includes prominent parks, forests, and trails such as Fatima Jinnah Park, Shakarparian Park and Margalla Hills National Park etc. The city is also home to several landmarks, including the Faisal Mosque, which is one of the largest mosques in South Asia. Other landmarks include the Pakistan Monument and Democracy Square. There are many outdoor activities and places to visit and enjoy in the city, such as Damn-e-Koh, Rawal Lake, and Lake View Park.

Islamabad and Rawalpindi, which are considered 'twin cities' are connected by Metro Bus service and other modes of public transport. Uber, Careen, In-drive, and Yango rides are available at nominal rates and are used frequently by locals as well as tourists. Rawalpindi / Islamabad also has a sightseeing bus service that takes tourists around to enjoy numerous landmarks and destinations. Additionally, Pakistan Railways has recently started a safari train that takes tourists from Golra station in Rawalpindi to Attock Fort and back. Pakistan International Airlines also started 'Sadpara Air Safari' named after the prominent mountaineer Ali Sadpara which flies over the snow-capped peaks including K2, Nanga Parbat and the famous Saif ul Maluk lake.
